- **Elections**
 - After election of new/returning board members (Adam Berlin, Glenn Sewell, Nikki Cleaveland) at the annual meeting, the board determines which officer positions will be vacant
 - Matt Gaston is stepping down as president, Laura Scott is stepping down as vice-president, but will remain as a board member. Forrest Daniels and Laura Mervilde will remain as treasurer and secretary, respectively
 - Nikki Cleaveland nominates Rich Leopold as vice president
 - Rich nominates Nikki for president
 - There are no other nominations and the board approves of both nominations
- **Treasurer's Report**
 - Forrest will be submitting required chapter financial report to Bloomington on 2/28; current balance \$2,800
 - Matt and Forrest will discuss scholarship fund offline
- **General IUAA News – Matt Gaston**
 - There are changes going on in Bloomington: the club will now be referred to as a chapter of IUAA (club vs. chapter); we may be changing officer terms to coincide with the fiscal year (ends in June) and standardize the terms across all clubs/chapters.

 - Hands on DC – asks if anyone wants to help with an event possibly in April or May
 - Program works with DC schools
- **Social**
 - Nikki asks everyone to be on the lookout for bars good for game-watching and email any suggestions to her
 - John emphasizes that any bar we choose (as a possible replacement of Ramparts) needs to be willing to show an IU game whether 30 people or 3 people show up
 - Adam notes that we don't want to pick a bar that is too far out from DC (uses the Baltimore club as an example)

- Glenn/Laura Scott state that we have a block of tickets for Hairspray at the Kennedy Center – look for info in the near future
- Other members suggest getting more involved in community service
- The board then discusses the possibility of Jared Jeffries attending a game viewing at Ramparts; John will look into games for the remainder of the season.
