## **Other Accolades**

- The first such school in the nation, the **School of Health, Physical Education, and Recreation** has the seventh-ranked doctoral program in kinesiology, according to the American Academy of Kinesiology and Physical Education.
- The first such school in the nation, the **School of Informatics and Computing** includes the nation's first PhD in informatics. The school was also named an "IT School to Watch" by *Computerworld* magazine.
- The **School of Journalism** was named the 2010 Hearst National Journalism Intercollegiate Writing Champion.
- *U.S. News & World Report* ranks the **School of Nursing** 15th; two of its programs are in the top 10.

## **IU Faculty Honors**

- **IU scholars** include eight Nobel Laureates, seven Pulitzer Prize winners, five MacArthur Fellows, and more than 30 active and emeritus members of the National Academies and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
- The IU faculty includes 123 Guggenheim Fellows, more than any other institution in Indiana. Since 1998, at least one IU faculty member has won a fellowship each year. IU also has 42 American Association for the Advancement of Science Fellows. Only 10 other institutions have more AAAS Fellows than IU.
