SUBJ: Trustee Election

As this year's trustee election gets underway, I thought it would be a good idea to remind you of the IU Alumni Association's policy concerning elections. The policy states that:

1. Neither the general Alumni Association nor any alumni club, constituent society, or affiliate group may endorse an individual candidate running for the position of trustee or contribute money in support of a campaign.
2. Alumni mailing labels and lists may not be released to candidates or their supporters.
3. Alumni newsletters may contain news that a particular person is running from a particular area, but it also must mention the other candidates.

In short, the IUAA and all of its various groups and organizations must remain neutral in the election process.

This policy is not intended to restrict or hamper alumni, acting on their own behalf, from actively supporting the candidate of their choice. It only applies to our various alumni groups.

Ballots will be mailed beginning in mid-May to all degree holders. The ballots are due on or before Wednesday, June 30.

Finally, please be sure to vote in the election; it's an important way to participate in the life of the university. Thanks for your cooperation.
